1. **Students are not permitted to be on campus during their approved late arrival/early release time.**
 By signing this form, you are stating that your child has transportation arranged which will enable him/her to arrive late or leave early according to the terms of this application.
2. I understand that my child may not earn the maximum number of academic credits possible in this academic year.
3. Students must take and pass a minimum of three (3) classes per semester to be eligible for athletic and extra-curricular activities. Students need to be enrolled in a minimum of three (3) classes per semester to be considered a full-time student.
4. It is the responsibility of the student/parent to contact any appropriate college/university admissions offices to verify that a reduced class load will not affect their application for college admission.
5. It is the student's responsibility to resend any transcripts that have already been sent to colleges/universities; failure to do so may jeopardize the student's potential enrollment in a college/university.
6. Early release or late arrival approval is subject to review at any time by the school's administration. Any student who does not meet the expectations around early release or late arrival or who is at risk of not graduating is subject to this approval being revoked.
