Dear Counselor, Potential Applicant, or SAME Member,

The **Fort Bragg Post** of the Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) again has college scholarships it will award. The total scholarship fund for 2019 is estimated at **\$12,000**. Scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving applicants based on academic achievement, participation in extracurricular activities, and their desire to pursue an engineering-based degree in college.

The amount of the scholarship award will be based on the merits of the applicant. There will be one award given to an applicant, selected by the committee, which has the potential to be a perpetual award for the duration of their undergraduate efforts, for a maximum of four years. All other awards are one-time awards. Past winners, and past applicants that met the eligibility requirements are welcome to apply again for the scholarship.

The applicant must submit a completed application by **April 24, 2019**. To be eligible for a scholarship the applicant must meet the following requirements within an **engineering, architectural, or construction management** curriculum:

- (1) Be a **high school senior residing in North Carolina or having graduated from a high school in North Carolina** who has been accepted, or is planning to enroll, at an accredited college or university,

OR

Be a **current undergraduate student** at an accredited college or university **in North Carolina** with a baccalaureate degree program,

OR

Be a **current undergraduate student at a North Carolina** technical community college with an associate degree program, after which the student plans to transfer to a four-year school with an engineering, architectural, or construction management curriculum.

- (2) Have a minimum of a B average (3.0 on 4.0 scale), whether high school or college.
- (3) Provide a completed application form with all required supporting information.

After selections have been made, winning individuals will be contacted by the Scholarship Committee. The winners will be presented their scholarship checks at the **June 25, 2019** membership luncheon meeting of the Fort Bragg SAME Post.
